Cecil Elementary School is a Title I school that serves 373 students in the East Baltimore Midway neighborhood. Cecil serves a predominantly African-American population (at over 97%). The student population has seen an increase in enrollment from 322 students previously to its current attendance levels. The school boasts a low suspension rate, with only 10 suspensions the previous school year, and a strong attendance rate of 94.3%. However, 12.3% of the school's population is categorized as chronically absent.

School Survey results indicate a high level of physical security satisfaction, with over 80% of parents feeling that the building is secure, and over 90% of parents feeling connected to the school. Cecil Elementary is a Gifted and Advanced Learning (GAL) site and boasts heavy academic enrichment opportunities for its youth, working closely with Johns Hopkins Center for Talented Youth and with Johns Hopkins for tutoring. The school also provides a theatre program that supports student development through the performing arts. Cecil also hosts a Youth Sports Afterschool Program that is run in-house and includes a male mentoring program.
