School Overview

- Hilton Elementary School #21 is a traditional neighborhood-based public school serving students in grades Pre-K through 5 in Northwest Baltimore. Located near Lake Ashburton and the communities of Gwynn Oaks and Hanlon Park, Hilton plays a vital role in the surrounding neighborhood. As a Schoolwide Title I school and a designated Maryland Green School, Hilton emphasizes both academic achievement and environmental responsibility.

- Total Enrollment: 252 students
- 92% Black
- 6% Hispanic
- 24% Students with Disabilities
- 86% Title I Eligibility Poverty Rate

Faculty & Staff

- The school is staffed by 20 teachers and a total of 48 staff members, with an impressive average teacher tenure of 10 years.

Family & Community Engagement

- According to the City Schools Family Survey (SY 2024–25):
 - 91% of families reported being mostly or extremely satisfied with the school.
 - 88% felt the school was preparing their child academically.
 - 94% gave positive feedback regarding the school climate.
