



Family League Releases 2025 Annual Report: Investing With Intention Reaches Over 18,000 Baltimoreans

\$21.6 Million Deployed Across 64 Community Partners as National Recognition Affirms Baltimore's Model for Family-Centered Change

Baltimore, MD – September 12, 2026 – Family League today released its [2025 Annual Report, "Investing With Intention,"](#) detailing a year of strategic alignment, measurable results, and citywide reach. In FY2025, Family League deployed \$21.6 million across 64 funded partners, directly benefiting more than 18,000 children, youth, and adults across Baltimore.

The report marks the first year Family League has organized its programming around Governor Wes Moore's ENOUGH Initiative, mapping its work across four priority areas: Cradle to Career Education, Healthy Families, Economically Secure Families, and Safe & Thriving Communities. Highlights include serving 8,135 youth through Community Schools and Out-of-School Time programming—26% above target, with attendance far outpacing national benchmarks; supporting 316 families through Healthy Families America home visiting; and anchoring more than \$6.3 million in cumulative housing support since 2020.

Family League's model earned national recognition this year as a featured case study from both the Wallace Foundation and the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine. The organization also earned its third consecutive Platinum Transparency Seal from Candid GuideStar and closed the year with \$25.3 million in total revenue.

"Every page of this report tells the same story from a different angle: what happens when a city decides that no single program, and no single sector, can end child poverty alone," said Demaune A. Millard, President & CEO of Family League. "As you read what follows, I hope you see what I see: a city that is learning, in real time, how to invest with intention."

"These investments were carried out with purpose and discipline," said Nancy Blackwell, Board Chair. "Baltimore's families and communities are stronger because of you."
